

Criteria for the Acceptance of International Students

Nancy Campbell Collegiate Institute is a private international school with a goal of inspiring academic excellence within a clear moral leadership framework in all students. Our motto, *unity in diversity*, means that we expect students who enter our program to be interested in making friends from around the world and respecting individual and cultural differences as part of the global mosaic. Those who apply to enroll at NCCI must be committed to study, service in the community and to upholding the high standards of behavior and attitude expected of NCCI students.

Following is the list of expectations that those who apply for admission must be able to meet:

1. Above average achievement in courses being studied at their current school
2. Comfortable listening , speaking and writing in English with a TOEFL minimum score of 60
3. Excellent attendance at their current school
4. Recommendation from the Head of their current school
5. Original copies of previous School records from past two grades (Translations of records must be Notarized and sealed officially if original is in a language other than English)
6. Recommendation of their good character and commitment to service in the community from a non family member (Teacher, Religious leader, Club or Extracurricular leader, etc...)
7. Completion of the NCCI Interview; in person, by phone or written and returned by email if applicant is not able to speak English fluently
8. Willing to complete 50 hours of community service each year that they are enrolled at NCCI
9. Committed to excellence both academically and ethically
