Grades 1-6

Grades 7 & 8

→**Please note:** From year to year courses may be offered depending on the interest of students. Students are not restricted to taking courses in their grade level except for mandatory subjects. However, they may not reach more than two years beyond their grade level. Only eight courses can be taken each year. Students should submit course selections prior to June 1st to increase the likelihood that the courses chosen will be offered.
